Employment Services and MORE!

Disciples of the Way Ministries opened the Refugee Service Center (RSC) six months ago to counsel our Refugee Neighbors, assist them with job placement, and help them with many other problems that affect their lives daily.

The Refugee Service Center focuses on creating relationships with employers to gain employment for our Refugee Neighbors. In the last 6 months, the RSC has found jobs for over 60 refugees. But we haven't stopped there!

The RSC is not only focused on employment assistance. Our refugee neighbors come in broken and depressed, with a variety of problems and needs. Disciples of the Way ministries is dedicated to holistic ministry; "holy-istic" ministry and "whole-istic" ministry.




RSC Staff interpreters describe the job expectations on a tour of the Anatole Hotel.

RSC Medical Assistance

An Iraqi man came into our office with only a 4 day supply of insulin left. He had no insurance to be able to afford a refill. So, the Director of the RSC, Hisham Batar, took him at 7am to a local hospital which offers a charity insurance program.

Over the course of the day, the right documents were found and the paperwork was filed for both him and his wife. He was able to get his insulin and was so grateful for the help he received from RSC.



The RSC has met its goal of assisting Refugee Neighbors to find jobs and provide for their families' needs. The RSC also helps our neighbors to apply for healthcare, affordable housing, food stamps, and attend citizenship classes.

RSC Housing Assistance

A Sudanese single mother was evicted from her apartment because she was living in a one bedroom apartment with all her children. She came to the office homeless. The RSC helped find temporary housing for them through a local church. Then, we found her a job and a 3-bedroom apartment she could afford.




The RSC staff help Refugee Neighbors fill out applications. They also explain how the American work culture is different and what the expectations are.
