Christians & Muslims of Disciples of the Way's (DOW) Arabic Bible Study under the Tree of Knowledge and Evil at the Institute of Creation Research in Dallas.

God is not far from His creation and He is bringing us closer to Him!

Recently the Muslim and Christian members of DOW's Arabic Bible Study visited the Institute for Creation Research (ICR) and enjoyed seeing the Creationist exhibits at the Institute and attend a planetarium show. The trip to ICR helped visually explain the creation account in Genesis which our Bible study has recently studied.

Muslims and Christians believe that God created the earth by his word but Muslims have an entirely different view of the Fall of Man. The Quran says that Adam forgot God's command to not eat and that the relationship with God was not broken because Adam did not really sin. The Bible makes clear the severity of Adam's sin and the way that the whole earth changed because of it. But God in the Bible did stop there, he sent the new Adam to redeem humanity from sin; the Crucified Christ, the God that the Quran denies. (Quran Sura 4:175)

"You shall treat the stranger who sojourns with you

**as the native among you, and you shall love him as yourself."
- Leviticus 19:34a**

"Sojourn" is not a word we commonly use anymore in English. It has been replaced by the word "refugee" in our modern world. A person who is displaced from their homeland and lives in another country.

Paul declares in Acts 17:26:

***"And he made from one man
every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth,
having determined allotted periods
and the boundaries of their dwelling place,..."
- Acts 17:26***

God has placed the people of the world exactly where He has plans for them. God commanded his people to reach out to the refugees, foreigners, and the displaced with compassion and empathy. God welcomed us, sinners, into His kingdom of righteousness because of the love, life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. (John 3:16; John 12:32)

The God of John 3:16 knows no bounds. He is the God of the whole world and he wants His people to welcome other people so He can be their God too. (Matt 28:19-20)
