*"Sow for yourselves righteousness; reap
steadfast love; break up your fallow ground, for
it is the time to seek the Lord, that he may come
and rain righteousness upon you."*

Hosea 10:12



Here we are exhorted to sow righteousness to our lives and reap steadfast love among our neighbors. Our lives are determined by the type of seed we plant in our hearts and minds to impact our neighbors and connect them to Jesus. We reap

what we sow and we sow what we reap. If we sow the Word of God, we will reap fruits of righteousness. However, God does not need our fruits of righteousness but our neighbor does. **(Matt 16:37-40)**

"Refugee Service Care Center" RSCC @ a Glance

So far in the first six
months of 2022 DOW's

Refugee Service Care Center and its Extended Case Management Care program has assisted 220+ refugees from Iraq, Syria, Afghanistan, Burma, Ethiopia, Eritrea, South Africa, and the Ukraine.



The RSCC assists with serious issues pertaining to: Applications for Job Placements; Social Security, School Enrollment, Green Card and Citizenship Applications; Referrals to medical clinics; Food Stamps; Housing issues; and Citizenship test preparation classes. Our missionaries make follow-up home visits to the families to connect them, one person, one family at a time, to Jesus through weekly Bible Studies.

Comfort Blanket Mission/Baby Blanket Program "Go and Sew" continues:



An exciting new arm of the Comfort Blanket Mission is the Baby Blanket Program. Showing God's love of children.

The blanket mission also has enabled DOW to Sow Seeds of Faith (SSOF) by hiring refugee women to sew the blankets, helping them get out of their homes, learn or increase their sewing ability, and helping them gain self-esteem and independence as they can earn income to help with their family budget. These baby blankets are very well made and very popular among churches. Congregations offer them as great gifts for Baptism, Baby Showers, birthdays and Christmas presents. Ahmed was born with Down's Syndrome. He is the eldest of 4 brothers. His family was forced to flee Iraq in 2021. Just a few months after their arrival in the U.S., the father of the family who had been attending DOW's Wednesday Bible Study, died suddenly of a heart attack. DOW took the family under its "wing".

Ahmed's three brothers, who have been attending DOW's ESL classes, now have jobs to support the family. However, Ahmed was left behind, missing his father. When the family recently moved to Arlington Ahmed's days spent alone with his mother got longer.



After a long search, DOW's RSCC Director located Green Oaks school, a Christian special-care school for children like Ahmed, located in Arlington.

Ahmed attended Green Oaks Summer Program, and has now been welcomed into a three-year, life-prep program for adults with disabilities. Ahmed's smiling face shows how happy he is. He will

attend school three days a week. He is learning English, learning to socialize with other young people, and learning life skills for his future.

We thank the Lord for Green Oaks school for welcoming Ahmed as one of their own, and for putting Christ into education.
