It starts with God telling Abraham to take his son up a mountain to sacrifice him. The Jews and Christians believe the son taken to the mountain was Issac.

"After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, "Abraham!"

And he said, "Here I am."

He said, "Take your son,
your only son Isaac, whom you love,
and go to the land of Moriah,
and offer him there as a burnt offering
on one of the mountains of which I shall
tell you."

So Abraham rose early in the morning,

saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and his son Isaac. And he cut the wood for the burnt offering and arose and went to the place of which God had told him. "

Genesis 22:1-3

In the Islamic faith, Muslims believe Ismael is the son of Abraham's sacrifice. Even though the Qur'an does not specify the son's name.

Who is the True Sacrifice?

"The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"

John 1:29

Jesus Christ is the The True Sacrifice!

As it says in Exodus about the Passover Lamb...

Then Moses called all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go and select lambs for yourselves according to your clans, and kill the Passover lamb."

Take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and touch the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that is in the basin. None of you shall go

out of the door of his house until the morning.

For the Lord will pass through to strike the Egyptians, and when he sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the Lord will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to enter your houses to strike you."

Exodus 12:21-23

The sacrificial lamb protects people from God's judgement and covers their sin.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life."

John 3:16

God gave his beloved son, Jesus Christ, to die for all sinners so that whoever believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins and eternal life.
